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
## **Supply Fees**

#### "There's no such thing as bad weather, only bad clothes."

This phrase hails from Scandinavia, where it's a common mantra repeated by parents who insist that their children spend time outdoors every day.

In Sweden, the parental attitude is one of "freedom with responsibility," where children benefit from their experience with the various outdoor elements. Research confirms the importance of outdoor play and the ability of nature to foster child development all around -academically, emotionally, physically. There is value from dirt in boosting children's health and combating the high rates of asthma and allergies that now affect 40 percent of U.S. children.

We will follow the lead of this research by allowing the children to go outdoors every day, regardless of the weather, so please dress them appropriately. **Rubber boots, raincoats, and jackets with rain-repellent hoods are great to add to your child's wardrobe!** Learn more about the value of outdoor play, regardless of the weather conditions.
